#### "Here I raise mine Ebenezer."

This Sunday, Dec. 3, 2006, begins the 52<sup>nd</sup> year of the Ministry of Westboro Baptist Church in Topeka, Kan.

"Then Samuel took a stone, and set it between Mizpeh and Shen, and called the name of it Ebenezer, saying, Hitherto hath the Lord helped us."

1 Sam. 7:12.

"Thou tellest my wanderings: put thou my tears into thy bottle; are they not in thy book?" Psa. 56:8.

In spite of peril, toil and pain, Our course be onward still; We sow Topeka's barren plain, We'll reap on Zion's Hill.

Thou tellest my wanderings. Tellest (write it down and file it away so that it may be brought forth and celebrated – recounted in full and great and infinite detail – often throughout eternal years in Heaven – told about us with joy and thanksgiving, – with praise and honor and glory – to the Captain that led the children to glory, and to the children and each of them engaged in the battle). My wanderings (flittings – all little pieces of happenstance – flittings – flying about here and there like the aimless dartings about of the little humming bird – hither and yon – not knowing that each such event is a glorious part of an eternal master plan – God working in each little bird both to will and to do of God's good pleasure).

This is the ground of that serious and needful caution given at 1 Cor. 4:5: And then every man shall have praise of God. The Apostle's meaning is, every man that is praiseworthy, shall have praise of God; every good and faithful man, every true believer; all sincere and honest hearts, though they have been called hypocrites, and disgraced, though they have had the dirt of a thousand scandals cast in their faces, yet there is a day coming, when as all tears, so all reproaches shall be wiped away, and every man, that was called hypocrite, and wicked, shall then again have praise of God, his old certificate or Letters of commendation shall be renewed; A man perfect and upright, fearing God and eschewing evil. Job 1:1 - 'There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil." Read also, Heb. 13:20-21 - "Now the God of peace...Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is well-pleasing in his sight."
