19 *For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies:*

20 *These are the things which defile a man: but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not a man. (Matthew 5:13-20)*

14 *And when he had called all the people unto him, he said unto them, Hearken unto me every one of you, and understand:*

15 *There is nothing from without a man, that entering into him can defile him: but the things which come out of him, those are they that defile the man.*

16 *If any man have ears to hear, let him hear.*

17 *And when he was entered into the house from the people, his disciples asked him concerning the parable.*

18 *And he saith unto them, Are ye so without understanding also? Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, it cannot defile him;*

19 *Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats?*

20 *And he said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man.*

21 *For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders,*

22 *Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:*

23 *All these evil things come from within, and defile the man. (Mark 7:14-23)*
