Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.”** (Ezekiel 12:2) This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let's view some of this week's judgments from the proper perspective:

Holocaust Remembrance Day was this past week, on Thursday, April 12th. People around the world “honored” those that died during the Holocaust. Citizens of the country of Israel stood still for two minutes, as the Holocaust Remembrance Day siren sounded. The Holocaust is often referred to as the “worst Genocide in Human history”. The Jewish people have seen their share of Genocide, believe you me. What about Egypt? What about the Babylonian Captivity? What about Rome, and the destruction of Jerusalem by Titus? What about the 40 years wandering in the wilderness? Have you not read the Bible? Check it out for a history lesson on the Jewish people and how God has dealt with them for their willing disobedience. Israel was commanded to keep the commandments of the Lord their God, obey Him, and love Him. It was an everlasting covenant between them and God. They did not and have not obeyed. This is why the Lord curses you. **Ye shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and his testimonies, and his statutes, which he hath commanded thee. And thou shalt do that which is right and good in the sight of the LORD: that it may be well with thee, and that thou mayest go in and possess the good land which the LORD swore unto thy fathers, (Deut. 6:17-18)**

Observe and hear all these words which I command thee, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee for ever, when thou doest that which is good and right in the sight of the LORD thy God. (Deut. 12:28)

Early Saturday, on April 14th, more than 100 missiles were launched by the U.S. and its allies France and the U.K., targeting three chemical weapons sites in Syria. This air strike is in response to the Syrian government being accused of launching a chemical attack in the city of Douma last week. That chemical attack killed dozens. Again, this is simply an accusation, as the Pentagon is said to “still be assessing” the evidence but are confident in the decision. Syria and Russia (Syria's ally) deny the allegations. We shall see how the Lord causes this to play out. **And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. All these are the beginning of sorrows. (Matthew 24:6-8)**

Woe to you who have hardened your hearts against the Lord and His word. The destruction of this world is imminent; you must believe on Christ, repent of your sins, and seek the Lord with humility. **“For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon a desolation: they shall drive out Ashdod at the noon day, and Ekron shall be rooted up. Woe unto the inhabitants of the sea coast, the nation of the Cherethites! the word of the LORD is against you; O Canaan, the land of the Philistines, I will even destroy thee, that there shall be no inhabitant.”** (Zephaniah 2:4-5)
