Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2)** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing its people! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

On Tuesday, May 1st, the Public Religion Research Institute released a survey stating that acceptance of homosexuality is on the rise in Mormon circles, as over half of the sect are now voicing their acceptance of the God-condemned sin. It is trivial at best. Shame on the Public Religion Research Institute for even entertaining this survey. They clearly have no knowledge of the Bible, or they would know that **“Though hand join in hand, the wicked shall not be unpunished.” (Proverbs 11:21)** We are all the creation, put in place by the one and only Creator, as He saw fit.
