Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

(Genesis 6:5)** What awaits Mr. Cosby now is his eternal judgment, where his only hope is to spend every second of his remaining days humbly confessing his sins before God and seeking repentance, acknowledging that the only hope that he has is the Lord Jesus Christ. Don't live proudly in your sin, Mr. Cosby. Be ashamed and mourn.
