This so-called "Orthodox" church is of human invention—and is not the Church that Christ has built (Matthew 16:18). The word origin is late Middle English: from Greek *orthodoxos* (probably via ecclesiastical Latin), from *orthos* 'straight or right' + *doxa* 'opinion'. But, it is not Biblically sound, for many reasons including that they pray to saints, worship idols, worship and pray to Mary, and believe the loud lie that God loves everyone. And that's just for a start. That's about as crooked, perverse, and froward as you can get, friends! Not Orthodox!

What does the Bible say? The Bible teaches otherwise on each of these matters. These crooks justify the praying-to-saints lie, by saying it is like asking your friend to pray for you. The problem is that their "saints" are dead and are no longer in the position to "pray" for you. Their period of probation is complete and they no longer are called upon to "pray for" us. There is no example of it in the Bible; every time in the Bible where it happens, it is a live person asking that another live person/persons pray for them. This practice is one warned of as "doctrines of devils" by Paul in 1 Timothy Chapter 4.

The Bible teaches that such idol worship is abomination to God. Exodus 20:3: "Thou shalt have no other gods before me." Psalm 97:7: "Confounded be all they that serve graven images, that boast themselves of idols: worship him, all ye gods." God has chosen the manner in which he has revealed himself: through His word and His providences. These misguided fools justify their idols by lying and saying that the images they worship foster proper thoughts of God—when the opposite is true. The definition of unorthodox, we say.

Finally, Satan's loudest lie of this age is that "God loves everybody." This lie has nurtured the sodomite scourge now overrunning the world. The Bible answer is straight and plain—truly orthodox.
