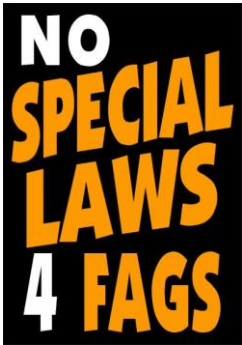

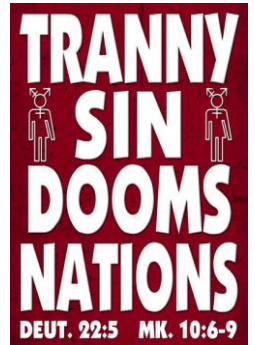

AMICUS CURIAE BRIEF OF WESTBORO BAPTIST CHURCH

FOR OCTOBER 8, 2019 ARGUMENTS



This is WBC's *amicus curiae* brief for Case Nos. 17-1618, 17-1623 and 18-107. Dozens of such briefs have been filed with the United States Supreme Court (SCOTUS); all are hapless. *Amicus curiae* means "friend of the court." There is no better friend of SCOTUS than WBC as she is called "the pillar and ground of the truth." (1 Timothy 3:15). What more could SCOTUS ask for?



On October 8 SCOTUS plans to take up the questions of whether sodomy (euphemistically called "sexual orientation") and transgenderism (just another form of sodomy) should be given special protected status under America's laws. The only principles SCOTUS needs to handle that task are

- "Remove not the ancient landmark, which thy fathers have set" (Proverbs 22:28);
- "Male and female created he them . . . in the day when they were created" (Genesis 5:2);
- "Have ye not read, that he which made them at the beginning made them male and female" (Mark 19:4); and,
- "But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine" (Titus 2:1).

Consider Dr. John Gill's remarks on Genesis 5:2 - *Male and female created he them,.... Adam and Eve, the one a male, the other a female; and but one male and one female, to show that one man and one woman only were to be joined together in marriage, and live as man and wife for the procreation of posterity; and these were not made together, but first the male, and then the female out of him, though both in one day[.]*
