Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2)** This entire world is a rebellious house! Riots sparked again this week in many countries: China, Iraq, Ecuador and France. Almost one hundred people were killed in Iraq’s riots with hundreds more injured around the world. **Psa 9:5 Thou hast rebuked the heathen, thou hast destroyed the wicked, thou hast put out their name for ever and ever. Psa 9:6 O thou enemy, destructions are come to a perpetual end: and thou hast destroyed cities; their memorial is perished with them. Psa 9:7 But the LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment. Psa 9:8 And he shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness. Psa 9:9 The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. Psa 9:10 And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.** The Lord did this to these countries and don’t think this will not happen to your country. You must be content with what the Lord gives you, but the people of Satan don’t think this way. **Psa 36:10 O continue thy lovingkindness unto them that know thee; and thy righteousness to the upright in heart. Psa 36:11 Let not the foot of pride come against me, and let not the hand of the wicked remove me. Psa 36:12 There are the workers of iniquity fallen: they are cast down, and shall not be able to rise.**
