God Almighty sent severe storms across the United States in these recent days. It was a mighty and terrible thing to behold. Here are just a few of the things that he wrought:

- On Friday, a wide-spread storm system moved across the country causing deadly crashes, damaging building, and fanning more than 150 wildfires in several states.
- The high winds fanning the wildfires have made air quality bad in most areas.
- More than a dozen tornadoes touched down in Missouri and Arkansas, and the Mississippi Valley prepares for tornadoes to surge through and into the Deep South.
- Texas suffered through dust storms, causing around 24 deadly crashes.
- Blizzards are expected to hit the Dakotas and Minnesota, along with heavy snow in regions of Arizona and Utah.
- Heavy winds are making travel through the Rockies and Northern Plains treacherous.

Thus far, 19 people have been confirmed dead and dozens injured. Not to mention the extensive damage to property and infrastructure. Let us now call to remembrance the words from the prophet Nahum of old and give heed and consider our ways. Praise God for it all.

**God [is] jealous, and the LORD revengeth; the LORD revengeth, and [is] furious; the LORD will take vengeance on his adversaries, and he reserveth [wrath] for his enemies. The LORD [is] slow to anger, and great in power, and will not at all acquit [the wicked]: the LORD [hath] his way in the whirlwind and in the storm, and the clouds [are] the dust of his feet. He rebuketh the sea, and maketh it dry, and drieth up all the rivers: Bashan languisheth, and Carmel, and the flower of Lebanon languisheth. The mountains quake at him, and the hills melt, and the earth is burned at his presence, yea, the world, and all that dwell therein. Who can stand before his indignation? and who can abide in the fierceness of his anger? his fury is poured out like fire, and the rocks are thrown down by him. The LORD [is] good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that trust in him.
