

# JESUS CHRIST'S REFERENCES TO HELL, DAMNATION & JUDGMENT IN THE BIBLE

Nearly all "Christians" blindly proclaim that "God loves everyone," (even though it is not in the Bible a single time). The inconvenient truth is that there are hundreds and hundreds of verses in the Bible that clearly state otherwise. Below are direct or veiled references to hell, damnation and judgment from the lips of the Lord Jesus Christ in the New Testament. While some faux "Christians" try to argue that Christ/God "loves" the people in hell, on a real basis that seems difficult to believe given their never-ending pain and suffering.

No.	Bible Citation	Bible Verse
1.	Mat. 5:21	<i>Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the <b>judgment</b>.</i>
2.	Mat. 5:22	<i>But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the <b>judgment</b>; and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of <b>hell fire</b>.</i>
3.	Mat. 5:29	<i>And if thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be <b>cast into hell</b>.</i>
4.	Mat. 5:30	<i>And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be <b>cast into hell</b>.</i>
5.	Mat. 7:13	<i>Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that <b>leadeth to destruction</b>, and many there be which go in thereat.</i>
6.	Mat. 7:19	<i>Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and <b>cast into the fire</b>. 20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.</i>
7.	Mat. 8:11-12	<i>And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven. 12 But the children of the kingdom shall be <b>cast out into outer darkness</b>; there shall be <b>weeping and gnashing of teeth</b>.</i>
8.	Mat. 10:15	<i>Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrha in the <b>day of judgment</b>, than for that city.</i>
9.	Mat. 10:28	<i>And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to <b>destroy both soul and body in hell</b>.</i>
10.	Mat. 11:22	<i>But I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the <b>day of judgment</b>, than for you.</i>
11.	Mat. 11:23	<i>And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be <b>brought down to hell</b>: for if the mighty works, which have been done in thee, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.</i>

12.	Mat. 11:24	<i>But I say unto you, That it shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the <b>day of judgment</b>, than for thee.</i>
13.	Mat. 12:31	<i>Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy <b>Ghost shall not be forgiven</b> unto men.</i>
14.	Mat. 12:32	<i>And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, <b>it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come.</b></i>
15.	Mat. 12:36	<i>But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the <b>day of judgment.</b></i>
16.	Mat. 13:29-30	<i>But he said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the tares, ye root up also the wheat with them. 30 Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and <b>bind them in bundles to burn them</b>: but gather the wheat into my barn.</i>
17.	Mat. 13:40	<i>As therefore the tares are gathered and <b>burned in the fire</b>; so shall it be in the end of this world.</i>
18.	Mat. 13:41-42	<i>The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity; 42 <b>And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.</b></i>
19.	Mat. 13:49-50	<i>So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall come forth, and <b>sever the wicked from among the just</b>, 50 And shall <b>cast them into the furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.</b></i>
20.	Mat. 18:8	<i>Wherefore if thy hand or thy foot offend thee, cut them off, and cast them from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life halt or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet to be <b>cast into everlasting fire.</b></i>
21.	Mat. 18:9	<i>And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be <b>cast into hell fire.</b></i>
22.	Mat. 21:41	<i>They say unto him, He will <b>miserably destroy those wicked men</b>, and will let out his vineyard unto other husbandmen, which shall render him the fruits in their seasons.</i>
23.	Mat. 22:13	<i>Then said the king to the servants, <b>Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.</b></i>
24.	Mat. 23:14	<i>Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: <b>therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation.</b></i>
25.	Mat. 23:15	<i>Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, <b>ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.</b></i>

26.	Mat. 23:33	<i>Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, <b>how can ye escape the damnation of hell?</b></i>
27.	Mat 24:50	<i>The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of, 51 <b>And shall cut him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.</b></i>
28.	Mat. 25:30	<i><b>And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.</b></i>
29.	Mat. 25:41	<i>Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, <b>Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:</b></i>
30.	Mat. 25:46	<i><b>And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.</b></i>
31.	Mark 3:29	<i>But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:</i>
32.	Mark 6:11	<i>And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when ye depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrha <b>in the day of judgment,</b> than for that city.</i>
33.	Mark 9:43	<i>And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, <b>than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:</b></i>
34.	Mark 9:44	<i><b>Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.</b></i>
35.	Mark 9:45	<i>And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet <b>to be cast into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:</b></i>
36.	Mark 9:46	<i><b>Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.</b></i>
37.	Mark 9:47	<i>And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes <b>to be cast into hell fire:</b></i>
38.	Mark 9:48	<i><b>Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.</b></i>
39.	Mark 12:9	<i>What shall therefore the lord of the vineyard do? <b>he will come and destroy the husbandmen,</b> and will give the vineyard unto others.</i>
40.	Mark 12:39	<i>And the chief seats in the synagogues, and the uppermost rooms at feasts: <b>40 Which devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayers: these shall receive greater damnation.</b></i>
41.	Luke 10:14	<i>But it shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon <b>at the judgment,</b> than for you.</i>
42.	Luke 10:15	<i><b>15 And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted to heaven, shalt be thrust down to hell.</b></i>
43.	Luke 12:5	<i>But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: <b>Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell;</b> yea, I say unto you, Fear him.</i>
44.	Luke 13:27	<i>But he shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence ye are; depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity. <b>28 There shall be weeping and gnashing of</b></i>

		<b>teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you yourselves thrust out.</b>
45.	Luke 16:22	<b>And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; 23 <u>And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.</u></b>
46.	Luke 16:24	<b>And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, <u>that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.</u></b>
47.	Luke 16:25	<b>But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, <u>and thou art tormented.</u></b>
48.	Luke 16:28	<b>For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, <u>lest they also come into this place of torment.</u></b>
49.	Luke 17:29-30	<b>But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom <u>it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all. 30 Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of man is revealed.</u></b>
50.	Luke 20:16	<b>He shall come and <u>destroy</u> these husbandmen, and shall give the vineyard to others. And when they heard it, they said, God forbid.</b>
51.	Luke 20:46	<b>Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the markets, and the highest seats in the synagogues, and the chief rooms at feasts; 47 Which devour widows' houses, and for a shew make long prayers: <u>the same shall receive greater damnation.</u></b>
52.	John 3:36	<b>He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; <u>but the wrath of God abideth on him.</u></b>
53.	John 5:29	<b>And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; <u>and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.</u></b>
54.	Rev. 1:18	<b>I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; <u>and have the keys of hell and of death.</u></b>
