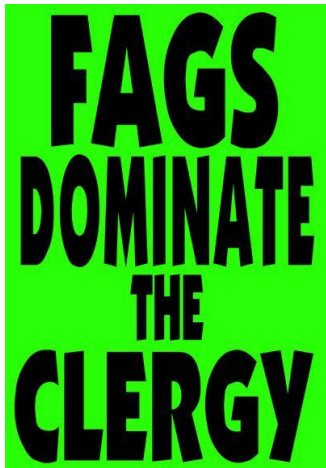

LORD WILLING, WBC TO PREACH TO DOOMED MISSOURI EPISCOPALIANS AT THE ORDINATION AND CONSECRATION OF "REVEREND" DEON KEVIN JOHNSON CHRIST CHURCH CATHEDRAL, 1210 LOCUST STREET, ST. LOUIS, MO SATURDAY, JUNE 13TH, FROM 10:15 - 10:55 AM



The Episcopal Diocese of Missouri continues a trajectory straight to hell as they plan an ordination and consecration ceremony to welcome elected Bishop "Reverend" Deon Kevin Johnson. WBC will be on the scene with the Bible perspective on this in hopes there would be any soft heart among those who see. And if not, just as well, it is the Lord.

Mr. Johnson is neither scripturally eligible to be considered a bishop, nor should he refer to himself as Reverend. Read what the scriptures say about those desiring the office of a bishop:

This is a true saying, If a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work. A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach; Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous; One that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity; (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?) Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil. Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil. (1Timothy 3:1-7)

Mr. Johnson does not have a wife, but rather a "husband". Perhaps Mr. Johnson is a novice, or at least he seems to have already fallen into the condemnation of the devil. Did Mr. Johnson miss this clearly stated standard about the office of a bishop? Or perhaps he never read the Bible standard about homosexuality? C'mon, guys, this is Bible 101. Likewise, the term "Reverend" is reserved in the Bible for only one, the LORD! *He sent redemption unto his people: he hath commanded his covenant for ever: holy and reverend is his name. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth for ever. (Psalm 111:9-10)*

So many things are wrong with this picture and this page is nearly full, yet only a tip of the iceberg has been addressed. The Episcopal Church is doomed. They do NOT his commandments, for which there is no hope for them!
