Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. Let's view some of this week's judgments from the proper perspective:

Civil unrest continued throughout the United States and in other Cities around the world. There were anti-racist protests responding to the death of George Floyd, the removing of Civil War monuments deemed racist, and calls to defund the police. In Seattle, protestors and anarchists even took over an area of the city calling it the Capitol Hill Autonomous Zone (CHAZ) and are operating in a "people run government free of cops." Racism is a sin and violence done to your fellow man is a sin, but instead of seeking to come up with solutions through fleshly reasoning and wisdom, turn to the Lord your God! **Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets. (Matthew 7:12)**

The standards of God are clear on all of these things, and your friends at Westboro Baptist Church beseech our neighbors throughout this country to heed these standards and humbly seek the Lord for mercy and repentance from your many grievous sins, as quickly as you can! If the Lord grant you that mercy and gift of repentance, then you will be given peace and given wisdom on what to do in all of these things.

Here is the standard of loving your neighbor (your fellow man): **Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD. (Leviticus 19:18)**

Jesus Christ spoke directly to the standards of loving your neighbor and what that means. Scripture (the Word of God - Christ) also speaks directly to the standards of soldiers (law enforcement at all levels) and that is what law enforcement officers at all levels should be obeying: **And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse any falsely; and be content with your wages. (Luke 3:14)**

Lastly, here is the standard concerning servants and masters and this applies to all walks of lives (teachers/students, bosses/employees, parents/children, officers/citizens, etc.): **Servants, be obedient to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ; Not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart; With good will doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men: Knowing that whatsoever good thing any man doeth, the same shall he receive of the Lord, whether he be bond or free. And, ye masters, do the same things unto them, forbearing threatening: knowing that your Master also is in heaven; neither is there respect of persons with him. (Ephesians 6:5-9)**

Because these standards are not obeyed, your zeitgeist is what it is today. Be ashamed, mourn, and turn to the Lord! That's the remedy.

Woe to you who have hardened your hearts against the Lord and His word. The destruction of this world is imminent; you must believe on Christ, repent of your sins, and seek the Lord with humility.
