Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2)** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

On Friday, September 18th, Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg died from complications related to pancreatic cancer at the age of 87. Ruth Bader Ginsburg spent the last 27 years of her life serving on the Supreme Court of the United States – otherwise known as the conscience of the nation – during which time this nation cemented its position fully against the God of Eternity. A quick search regarding Justice Ginsburg will show that she was a stark advocate for “women’s rights” (read the “right” to murder millions upon millions of unborn children) and is heralded as “the justice with the most pro-LGBTQ voting record in the history of the court”. **“Thou shalt not kill.” (Exodus 20:13) “Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.” (Romans 1:32)** Shame on Ruth Bader Ginsburg. Justice Ginsburg had a privileged platform from which she could sway the nation, which she used to push every form of godless filth that she could get her hands on, rather than stemming the tide of sin that this nation has become awash in. The same God she defied through these actions is *her* Judge, and let her death serve as a reminder that every member of Adam’s race has a day of Judgment coming and only the blood of Christ can wash you from your sins and save your undying soul from an eternity of torments. Don’t waste your days chasing your lusts, pursuing sin, and promoting the sins of others like Justice Ginsburg! Instead, spend your days in humble service to the King, warning your fellow man what awaits them if they don’t turn from their sins and repent. Justice Ginsburg found her life, filled with the pleasures of this world, and by all outward indicia has lost her eternal soul. **“He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.” (Matthew 10:39) “And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham’s bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented.” (Luke 16:22-25)**

This week has also seen the continued outpouring of the wrath of God across this land. Civil unrest continues, law enforcement officers continue to be assaulted by those they are supposed to be protecting, the number of coronavirus cases continue to mount, the west coast fires rage on, and the hurricanes persist in destruction. God sent each of these curses upon the united states, and they will continue in force up until He commands them to cease. **“See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand.” (Deuteronomy 32:39)** There will be no peace without intent and action towards serving God. Remember the example of Nineveh, where in the face of total destruction, the people from the king on down repented of their evil works and were delivered! **“And Jonah began to enter into the city a day’s journey, and he cried, and said, Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown. So the people of Nineveh believed God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them. For word came unto the king of Nineveh, and he arose from his throne, and he laid his robe from him, and covered him with sackcloth, and sat in ashes...Who can tell if God will turn and repent, and turn away from his fierce anger, that we perish not? And God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God repented of the evil, that he had said that he would do unto them; and he did it not.” (Jonah 3:4-6, 10)**

Woe to you who have hardened your hearts against the Lord and His word. The destruction of this world is imminent; you must believe on Christ, repent of your sins, and seek the Lord with humility. **“For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon a desolation: they shall drive out Ashdod at the noon day, and Ekron shall be rooted up. Woe unto the inhabitants of the sea coast, the nation of the Cherethites! the word of the LORD is against you; O Canaan, the land of the Philistines, I will even destroy thee, that there shall be no inhabitant.” (Zephaniah 2:4-5)**
