Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2)** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

Joe Biden has issued a litany of executive orders in his first week of presidency – allying himself with the perversions of the LGBT community in striking down Trump’s transgender military ban and in issuing an executive order disallowing employers to discriminate on the basis of gender identity and sexual orientation. If that sounds familiar, that would be because the Supreme Court already issued a similar ruling this last summer, leading one to concur that the purpose of Biden’s EO was purely to secure the support of society’s most perverse. Biden has also issued a memorandum “protecting women’s health at home and abroad” which is a lot of shielded language to get around saying he’ll be reallocating government funds toward non-profit abortion providers. (Lev. 18:30)

The death of talk show icon Larry King, a beloved media personality who has been on the airwaves of this country for nigh on 35 years, resounded across the U.S. last week. A self-proclaimed Jewish agnostic atheist, Mr. King has been wed eight times to seven women. Please reread that sentence. It would appear that Mr. King took Christ’s discourse with the woman who had five husbands as a challenge. Perhaps he should have read closer: **For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly. (John 4:18)** Is it not telling that this man, who can’t even pick his own idol, and who has so little respect for God’s holy institution of marriage is so revered in this day and age? Paul pegged his kind most accurately: **For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.
