WESTBORO BAPTIST CHURCH HOLDS FORTH THE GOSPEL OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST AGAINST 'FLORIDA GEORGIA LINE'

Tyler Hubbard and Brian Kelley – the country duo that call themselves “Florida Georgia Line” – began their music career in a church “praise band”, translated – self-glorifying entertainment to distract from Bible teaching. In 2010 they looked for greener pastures, and have since made millions, as they have been on the vanguard of “bro-country” music. This brand of country music combines traditional country with the sounds and themes of rock and hip-hop; focusing their lyrics on such things as partying, drinking, driving trucks, and sex. Their many hit songs glorify sin, while skillfully covering it with just the right amount of southern twang and phony “Christian” sounding concepts, that appeal to the sin-loving, yet self-righteous masses of red state America. They quite accurately describe their listeners with this lyric from their hit song Drinkin’ Beer, Talkin’ God, Amen: “I ain’t ever been the church goin’ type; Can’t quote much past 3:16 ... Church found me; sittin’ here drinkin’ beer, talkin’ God, Amen.” This is the picture of American “Christians”: create a version of God from your lustful, drunken hearts, and then worship that image that you have made, giving no thought to obeying the word of God, and living as Christ lived and commanded. In another of their songs: H.O.L.Y., they sing “Holy, Holy, Holy ...” – to whom do they offer this praise? To a woman that they are sleeping with! They go on to describe how they will employ their imagined prowess in the bedroom to get her to sing “Hallelujah!” God Forbid! The dull ears and fat hearts of American “Christians” love to hear this kind of vile slop that has just a hint of religious sounding words. This callous disregard for actual holiness and godliness has imperiled this nation, and will lead to her destruction!

Lord willing, WBC will be given the opportunity to preach and picket a Florida Georgia Line concert, to plead with our fellow Americans: stop conforming to this ever-darkening world, but rather believe on Jesus Christ, repent of your sins, and follow after Him.
