Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. Let's view some of this week's judgments from the proper perspective:

Many great and terrible events occurred this past week, by a Mighty and Just God. Here is just a sampling:

- On December 15th, at least 71 are dead after a gas tanker explosion in Haiti.
- On December 17th, Super Typhoon Rai hit the Philippines killing at least 75 people, thus far. Around 332,000 have been evacuated from their homes.
- In the U.S. on December 15th, there were intense, widespread violent storms rolling across the Rockies and into the Plains that produced severe weather, tornadoes, damaging winds, and extreme fire danger. 80 million people were impacted by the wind alerts (gusts between 100-200 mph) and 450,000 people were without power across nine states. So much more damage and disruption was reported across these same states. This all comes just days after an eight-state tornado outbreak and the deadliest tornado ever recorded in December. Over 80 people have been killed from these tornadoes and storms.

The Lord our God has granted the people of this world exceeding space for repentance. How long will you refuse to humble yourself before the Lord? Soon, all nations shall know that God, He is the Lord. As the Lord Jesus said, repent or ye shall all likewise perish (**Luke 13:3&5**).

God is jealous, and the LORD revengeth; the LORD revengeth, and is furious; the LORD will take vengeance on his adversaries, and he reserveth *wrath* for his enemies. The LORD is slow to anger, and great in power, and will not at all acquit *the wicked*: the LORD hath his way in the whirlwind and in the storm, and the clouds are the dust of his feet. He rebuketh the sea, and maketh it dry, and drieth up all the rivers: Bashan languisheth, and Carmel, and the flower of Lebanon languisheth. The mountains quake at him, and the hills melt, and the earth is burned at his presence, yea, the world, and all that dwell therein. Who can stand before his indignation? and who can abide in the fierceness of his anger? his fury is poured out like fire, and the rocks are thrown down by him.
