Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2)** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

In Petropolis, Brazil floods and landslides swept down the mountains killing 117 people, but that number can rise because more than 116 are still unaccounted for.

In Europe, Storm Eunice has killed 14 people so far, with deaths reported in Belgium, Netherlands, Germany, Poland, the Irish Republic, and the UK. Storm Eunice produced strong winds which toppled trees and sent debris flying.

In Beledweyne, Somalia, a suicide bomber killed 10 people on the eve of their election. The strike happened at a restaurant popular with politicians and local officials and one of the people killed was a candidate in Somalia’s ongoing parliamentary vote.

In Mali, eight soldiers were killed and five are missing after an attack by rebels in the north-eastern Arham region. The Malian air force killed 57 militants and 40 civilians.

With so much death, you must ask who did it? **“See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand.” Deu 32:39** The Lord your God created you and He can destroy you. Please listen to us. **“As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated. What shall we say then? Is there unrighteousness with God? God forbid. For he saith to Moses, I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion. So then it is not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy. For the scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew my power in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth. Therefore hath he mercy on whom he will have mercy, and whom he will he hardeneth. Thou wilt say then unto me, Why doth he yet find fault? For who hath resisted his will? Nay but, O man, who art thou that repliest against God? Shall the thing formed say to him that formed it, Why hast thou made me thus? Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour? What if God, willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction: And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory, Even us, whom he hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?” Rom 9:13-24**

In Phoenix, Arizona a priest incorrectly performed thousands of baptisms, he said **“we baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,”** instead of the correct phrase **“I baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”** There are many things we could focus on with what the Catholic church is doing wrong with baptisms, the biggest is baptizing infants. The so-called Catholic diocese of Phoenix said **“it is not the community that baptizes a person and incorporates them into the Church of Christ; rather, it is Christ, and Christ alone, who presides at all sacraments.”** Gag, these are the same priests who rape little children.
