Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2)** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

On April 12th, a man named Frank James opened fire in a subway train, injuring dozens including 10 by actual gunfire. By the mercy of God, no one has died. That being said, the people here will not give the glory to God for this mercy, nor will they hear the rod and who hath appointed it. They have set at naught all the LORD’s council, and they can only expect more and worse than this. Indeed:

The LORD’S voice crieth unto the city, and the man of wisdom shall see thy name: hear ye the rod, and who hath appointed it. Are there yet the treasures of wickedness in the house of the wicked, and the scant measure that is abominable? Shall I count them pure with the wicked balances, and with the bag of deceitful weights? For the rich men thereof are full of violence, and the inhabitants thereof have spoken lies, and their tongue is deceitful in their mouth. Therefore also will I make thee sick in smiting thee, in making thee desolate because of thy sins. (Micah 6:9-13)

There is no peace, saith the LORD, unto the wicked. (Isaiah 48:22)

Meanwhile, in Kansas, Governor Laura Kelly vetoed the “Fairness in Women’s Sports Act”, a bill that passed through the Senate and House with overwhelming favor. What can we say except that the LORD has requited you according to your ways! “Bible Belt” Kansas has had a front row seat to the preachments of God through His servants here at Westboro Baptist Church, and you pick and choose which of God’s standards you will follow. Don’t you know that the LORD is a *God of knowledge*, and by Him actions are weighed (*1 Samuel 2:3*)?

Therefore prophesy and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, O my people, I will open your graves, and cause you to come up out of your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel. And ye shall know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O my people, and brought you up out of your graves, and shall put my spirit in you, and ye shall live, and I shall place you in your own land: then shall ye know that I the LORD have spoken it, and performed it, saith the LORD. (Ezekiel 37:12-14)

Woe to you who have hardened your hearts against the Lord and His word. The destruction of this world is imminent; you must believe on Christ, repent of your sins, and seek the Lord with humility. **“For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon a desolation: they shall drive out Ashdod at the noon day, and Ekron shall be rooted up.
