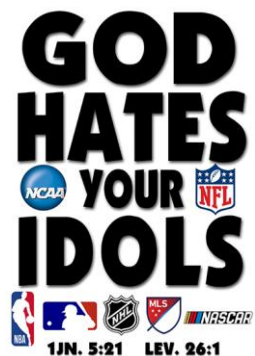
WRATH TO COME!
