Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2).** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

On Thursday, December 8, WNBA star Brittney Griner was released from Russian custody to the U.S. She had been arrested in February of this year for smuggling vape cartridges of a small amount of hash oil into Russia and sentenced to 9 years in prison. Griner was released as part of a prisoner exchange at an airport in Abu Dhabi, U.A.E. In exchange for Griner, the Biden Administration released Viktor Bout, a Russian arms dealer who had been arrested in 2008 and was serving a 25-year prison term for illegal arms dealing and aiding terrorist organizations. White House Press Secretary Karine Jean-Pierre celebrated Griner's release, agreeing with President Biden that "she represents the best of America." Former House Speaker Nancy Pelosi also celebrated, especially because Griner would be reunited with her "wife" the same day the House passed the Respect for Marriage Act. This law, once signed by the president, would force states that prohibit same-sex marriages to recognize them if they are conducted in another state, in the unlikely event that the Supreme Court overturns its 2015 decision to legalize same-sex marriage.

On Friday, American sports journalist Grant Wahl died at age 49 while covering the Argentina-Netherlands World Cup match in Doha, Qatar. He collapsed suddenly in the press box of the stadium; his cause of death is unknown. Earlier in the World Cup, in November, Wahl became viral in the media and social media, because he was briefly prevented from forcing his way into a match wearing a rainbow shirt, to push fag propaganda in a country that criminalizes that sin; he eventually was let in anyway.

What a waste of the lives God grants all of these people. Whether young or old, all of these people have been granted many years of life and they waste it spitting on God and His standards. This is the end of them all, so do not follow their example: **“Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah; They shall not lament for him, saying, Ah my brother! or, Ah sister! they shall not lament for him, saying, Ah lord! or, Ah his glory! Behold, I am against thee, saith the LORD of hosts; and I will discover thy skirts upon thy face, and I will shew the nations thy nakedness, and the kingdoms thy shame. And I will cast abominable filth upon thee, and make thee vile, and will set thee as a gazingstock. And it shall come to pass, that all they that look upon thee shall flee from thee, and say, Nineveh is laid waste: who will bemoan her? whence shall I seek comforters for thee?” (Nahum 3:4-7).**
