### **Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events**

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2).** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

On Thursday, April 27, anti-abortion bills failed to pass in two states where the legislature is led by Republicans. In Nebraska, the “Heartbeat Act” would have banned most abortions after 6 weeks, excluding cases of rape, incest, etc., once a heartbeat is detected. In South Carolina, the "Human Life Protection Act" would have banned all abortions, with exceptions similar to the Nebraska bill. The sin of abortion in America was put on the defense for a split second on June 24, 2022, when Roe v. Wade was overturned by the Supreme Court, and it’s been in a raging offense ever since. **"The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God." (Psalm 9:17).**

On Friday, sometime after 11:30 PM, a Mexican national in Cleveland, TX shot 5 people to death in their home. Neighbors had asked the man, who was drinking and shooting his gun in his back yard, to stop firing due to the noise; they also filed a complaint with law enforcement. Sometime later, he was caught on the victims’ doorbell camera approaching the house with a rifle. 10 people total were in the home, and 5 were murdered. The fear and terror over guns continues to build, because America hates God. **"But ye have set at nought all my counsel, and would none of my reproof: I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your fear cometh; When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you. Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me: For that they hated knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD" (Proverbs 1:25-29).**

On Tuesday, President Joe Biden released a 3 minute video announcing his candidacy for the 2024 presidential election. In the video, Biden says, "When I ran for president four years ago, I said we are in a battle for the soul of America. And we still are." First of all, that goose is practically cooked; just look at the landscape of America’s sins. Secondly, he must mean that he was, is, and will be battling on behalf of damning America’s soul further.
