## Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. "Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house." (Ezekiel 12:2). This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let's view some of this week's judgments from the proper perspective:

Politics is usually just modern-day blood sport and a rat race of greedy individuals using tribalism to vie for power, but it is sometimes useful to take a step back and take stock of our ruling class, especially after a week like this past one. Here is a quick roundup of recent political happenings.

**Lauren Boebert:** On Sunday, this U.S. congresswoman, who claims to be a Christian despite recently beginning divorce proceedings, was ejected from a musical production of Beetlejuice in Denver because she and her date were groping each other in their front row seats.

**Susanna Gibson:** On Monday, it became public that this candidate for the Virginia House of Delegates has recently posted videos of sex acts between her and her husband to a pornographic website for money. When confronted, she called this "an illegal invasion of my privacy designed to humiliate me and my family." She and her allies have used this scandal to fundraise for her hotly-contested race.

**U.S. Senate:** On Tuesday, this political body held a hearing on supposed "book bans" happening across U.S. schools.
