## Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week, and so let's view some of this week's judgments from the proper perspective:

The modern nation of Israel has been built on lies and the blood of their neighbors. Blinded by their lusts and abundance of idolatry, the Jews have forsaken the law of their Father and killed the Christ. "Pilate saith unto them, What shall I do then with Jesus which is called Christ? They all say unto him, Let him be crucified. And the governor said, Why, what evil hath he done? But they cried out the more, saying, Let him be crucified. When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ve to it. Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children." (Matthew 27:22-25) The result of this curse is seen to this day as even though they stole the land they now try to possess, while murdering and abusing the people who live there, and try to dust off their hands and act like they've done no wrong, they remain in a constant state of turmoil amongst their neighbors. "Even all nations shall say, Wherefore hath the LORD done thus unto this land? what meaneth the heat of this great anger? Then men shall say, Because they have forsaken the covenant of the LORD God of their fathers, which he made with them when he brought them forth out of the land of Egypt: For they went and served other gods, and worshipped them, gods whom they knew not, and whom he had not given unto them: And the anger of the LORD was kindled against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book: And the LORD rooted them out of their land in anger, and in wrath, and in great indignation, and cast them into another land, as it is this day." (Deuteronomy 29:24-28)

On Friday, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu spoke to the U.N. General Assembly about the efforts between Israel and Saudi Arabia to reach a peace agreement. Violence and unrest have multiplied in the last couple years after the 2020 "Abraham Accords." This agreement between four other surrounding nations, Bahrain, Morocco, Sudan, and the United Arab Emirates, was cited by Netanyahu to have "heralded the dawn of a new age of peace." However, this new agreement with Saudi Arabia is expected to be an even more meaningful accomplishment. The Saudi Crown Prince, Mohammed bin Salman, supported this on Wednesday saying the two countries are getting closer to an agreement every day. Meanwhile, Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas asserts there will be no peace until a Palestinian state is affirmed and given their full rights. These men seek to have peace on their own terms. God gives the peace. Obey Him.

"Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear. For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with iniquity; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue hath muttered perverseness. None calleth for justice, nor any pleadeth for truth: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity. They hatch cockatrice' eggs, and weave the spider's web: he that eateth of their eggs dieth, and that which is crushed breaketh out into a viper. Their webs shall not become garments, neither shall they cover themselves with their works: their works are works of iniquity, and the act of violence is in their hands. Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood: their thoughts are thoughts of iniquity; wasting and destruction are in their paths. The way of peace they know not; and there is no judgment in their goings: they have made them crooked paths: whosoever goeth therein shall not know peace." (Isaiah 59:1-8)
