## Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week. The Word of the Lord provides an appropriate standard through which we may view them from a proper perspective:

The Lord has called many this week to make account for their talents in this life from all around the globe and from all walks of life. (Matthew 25:14-30)

Henry Kissinger, former secretary of state and security advisor for Presidents Nixon and Ford, passed away on Wednesday, November 29 at the age of 100. Similarly, Sandra Day O'Connor, first female to be appointed to the Supreme Court died at the age of 93 on Friday, December 1. Without a doubt, these were two people given great power and influence in this world and received their good things (Luke 16:19-31) while misusing the talents provided by their Creator. Kissinger was known for his hand in the bombings of Cambodia, as well as the creation of the security state of the United States formed during the Cold War. He advised 12 presidents, a level of influence few others could claim. O'Connor, amongst other things, refused to overturn the Roe v. Wade decision in 1989 despite her claim to find the act offensive on a personal level stating "[o]ur obligation is to define the liberty of all, not to mandate our own moral code." The liberty of those babies apparently wasn't accounted for. There are an estimated 73 million abortions per year at this point in history. More than 2 per second. That blood is on your hands, Ms. O'Connor. Your obligation, and that of all people, is to uphold the morals and standard of your God. Your morals are corrupt. These two have very likely been found to be unprofitable servants and are cast into outer darkness by the very hands of that King who they failed to serve in faith. They did evil because they prepared not their heart to seek the Lord. (2 Chronicles 12:14)

"The wicked worketh a deceitful work: but to him that soweth righteousness shall be a sure reward. As righteousness tendeth to life: so he that pursueth evil pursueth it to his own death. They that are of a froward heart are abomination to the LORD: but such as are upright in their way are his delight. Though hand join in hand, the wicked shall not be unpunished: but the seed of the righteous shall be delivered." (Proverbs 11:18-21)

Last week's temporary truce between Israel and Hamas crumbled on Friday as Israel resumed the slaughter of human lives after Hamas reportedly only returned 8 hostages instead of the 10 that were promised. Within hours, Israel had already executed over 200 airstrikes leading to a reported 178 new deaths added to the more than 13,300 that have been estimated to have lost their lives to date, most of whom are civilian women and children. Both sides of the conflict direct blame at one another and any other institution or nation that steps in. These truly are bloody men who have forgotten God. "Surely thou wilt slay the wicked, O God: depart from me therefore, ye bloody men. For they speak against thee wickedly, and thine enemies take thy name in vain." (Psalm 139:18-19)
