Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. Let's view some of this week's judgments from the proper perspective:

This very day, the United Kingdom's prime minister is scheduled to recognize Palestinian statehood in (feeble) hope of bringing peace to the Middle East with a two state solution. The layers of hypocrisy must be peeled back to fully appreciate the scope and stature of its grandiloquence and pomposity. First, this is a very rich posture to take when one considers the old saying "The sun never sets on the British Empire" (*Isaiah 48:22*). Second: as a country, the United Kingdom has wholesale rejected and banned the gospel from being spoken in its borders and made this its defacto position:

Therefore hear ye the word of the LORD, all Judah that dwell in the land of Egypt; Behold, I have sworn by my great name, saith the LORD, that my name shall no more be named in the mouth of any man of Judah in all the land of Egypt, saying, The Lord GOD liveth. (Jeremiah 44:26)

Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God. (Matthew 5:9)

For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile: Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it. For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil. (1 Peter 3:10-12)

God has cursed your country! You have banned the peacemaking ministers of the eminently reasonable Gospel from your borders so that the name of God would no more be named, and then you allowed idolatrous, wild men (Muslims) into your country like fire in your bosom (*Genesis 16:12, Proverbs 6:27*). You have hated life and so love death (*Proverbs 8:35-36*)! And now you would presume to put your hands on a conflict that is older than your very country, and arrogate the power to bring peace to yourself? Consider the scriptures:

He that passeth by, and meddleth with strife belonging not to him, is like one that taketh a dog by the ears. (Proverbs 26:17)

Behold, the day of the LORD cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee. For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city. Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle. (Zechariah 14:1-3)

You are not going to thwart the purpose of God (*Isaiah 55:11, Proverbs 19:21*).

Woe to you who have hardened your hearts against the Lord and His word. The destruction of this world is imminent; you must believe on Christ, repent of your sins, and seek the Lord with humility. "For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon a desolation: they shall drive out Ashdod at the noon day, and Ekron shall be rooted up. Woe unto the inhabitants of the sea coast, the nation of the Cherethites! the word of the LORD is against you; O Canaan, the land of the Philistines, I will even destroy thee, that there shall be no inhabitant." (*Zephaniah 2:4-5*)
