## Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. Let's view some of this week's judgments from the proper perspective:

Dick Van Dyke turned 100 years old on Saturday, December 13<sup>th</sup>. What a blessing to receive such long life! Oh that men would praise and glorify the God of Eternity! In looking back at his life, from what can be gleaned by public evidence, he taught sin and spoke evil about God. There are many examples from the long life that the Lord his God gave him, but here is one sampling from a 2015 interview where he spoke about a Kentucky clerk not giving marriage licenses to sodomites:

He said: *"It seems to me, in my opinion, that she misread, or misunderstood the biblical admonition. The admonition was for people who practice homosexuality. There's nothing in there about the rest of it, casting judgement on them or administering the punishment. That's God's job... I think, really, she's got it wrong. She's not supposed to administer the punishment. Some people never change their mind through their whole lives, about anything, despite new information that comes in. And now that we know that homosexuality is not a choice, it's biological, I think we have to love and understand them."*

These are those people, Mr. Van Dyke: **"But the men of Sodom were wicked and sinners before the LORD exceedingly." (Genesis 13:13)**

**O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things. But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned. (Matthew 12:34-37)**

Oh that Mr. Van Dyke would find the kind of wisdom that King Solomon had when he realized what the purposes of our lives were about:

**Vanity of vanities, saith the preacher; all is vanity. And moreover, because the preacher was wise, he still taught the people knowledge; yea, he gave good heed, and sought out, and set in order many proverbs. The preacher sought to find out acceptable words: and that which was written was upright, even words of truth. The words of the wise are as goads, and as nails fastened by the masters of assemblies, which are given from one shepherd. And further, by these, my son, be admonished: of making many books there is no end; and much study is a weariness of the flesh. Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this [is] the whole duty of man. For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil. (Ecclesiastes 12:8-14)**
