## Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2)** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

Once again an officer-involved shooting has rocked the US political landscape as both sides of the aisle scramble to convince the greater populace on whether the killing of thirty-seven-year-old Renee Nicole Good by an ICE agent in Minneapolis on Wednesday was justified. For the promontory dwellers, this happened in the wake of President Trump’s deployment of 2,000 ICE agents to the city to crack down and deport “fraudsters, murderers, rapists, and gang members,” specifically those of Somalian descent who’ve been caught in recent months defrauding government programs. As ICE began ratcheting up their activities in Minneapolis, local left-wing activists engaged in a counter-campaign of trailing and obstruction. It was under this backdrop that the incident occurred. After persistent obstruction of Immigration Enforcement personnel, officers surrounded Mrs. Good’s car and attempted to open her driver’s side door and place her under arrest. Panicked by this, Mrs. Good tried to drive away with an officer still in front of her vehicle, who proceeded to unload his firearm into the driver as he sidestepped the car, killing her. Outrage has surged and resurged in the days since the shooting as new angles of the incident were revealed and the personal history of the involved parties have been divulged. Many rushed to paint Mrs. Good as a God-fearing Christian, a legal American citizen, and a loving mother of three who died exercising her right to free speech. All this, notwithstanding that Mrs. Good was a practicing Sodomite “married” to another woman, Becca Good, who was actually present during the incident. Becca’s last words to her spouse were to urge her to disobey a lawful command from law enforcement, resulting in her own “wife’s” death. **“Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation.”** Of course, Mrs. Good not only resisted God by proxy but also directly, as evidenced by her refusal to submit unto Christ’s command here: **And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh? Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder (Mt 19: 5-6.)** As for the ICE officer who shot her, lawful or not, we should remember how our God would have us act, and that the Lord will judge: **And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse any falsely; and be content with your wages (Lu 3:14.) The LORD shall judge the people: judge me, O LORD, according to my righteousness, and according to mine integrity that is in me. Oh let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end; but establish the just: for the righteous God trieth the hearts and reins. My defence is of God, which saveth the upright in heart (Ps 7: 8-10.)**

In the wake of his seizure of Nicolas Maduro on the third, Trump has become increasingly aggressive in his application of pressure to hostile foreign powers such as Iran who’s been recently cracking down on protests against the present regime which are entering their third week. Trump has warned Iran’s leadership that “as soon as you begin shooting so do we.” Even allies have not been spared as the president has revived his intentions to dispossess Denmark of Greenland, as well as indicated that he intends to commence a military ground operation in Mexico to combat the Cartels. When asked if there were any limits to his global powers, Trump responded “Yeah, there is one thing. My own morality. My own mind. It’s the only thing that can stop me.” Consider Mr. President: **“And the people gave a shout, saying, It is the voice of a god, and not of a man. And immediately the angel of the Lord smote him, because he gave not God the glory: and he was eaten of worms, and gave up the ghost” (Acts 12:23)**

Woe to you who have hardened your hearts against the Lord and His word. The destruction of this world is imminent; you must believe on Christ, repent of your sins, and seek the Lord with humility. **“For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon a desolation: they shall drive out Ashdod at the noon day, and Ekron shall be rooted up.
