Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. Let's view some of this week's judgments from the proper perspective:

In New York City this week, Judge Margaret Garnett dismissed the murder charge against Luigi Mangione. This is that Luigi Mangione who murdered the United Healthcare CEO Brian Thompson. Yes, this is that Luigi Mangione who with guile and covered face came presumptuously upon his neighbor to slay him in cold blood while his back was turned. And yet Judge Garnett dismissed the charge of murder on the argument that the law requires the killing to be committed during another crime of violence. Is the violence in New York not made out of violence? What is this twisting and mincing of words to wrest judgment? Hear the word of the LORD!

He that smiteth a man, so that he die, shall be surely put to death... But if a man come presumptuously upon his neighbour, to slay him with guile; thou shalt take him from mine altar, that he may die. (Exodus 21:12,14)

Moreover ye shall take no satisfaction for the life of a murderer, which is guilty of death: but he shall be surely put to death. And ye shall take no satisfaction for him that is fled to the city of his refuge, that he should come again to dwell in the land, until the death of the priest. So ye shall not pollute the land wherein ye are: for blood it defileth the land: and the land cannot be cleansed of the blood that is shed therein, but by the blood of him that shed it. Defile not therefore the land which ye shall inhabit, wherein I dwell: for I the LORD dwell among the children of Israel. (Numbers 35:31-34)

It was reported that *Deny*, *Defend* and *Depose* were written, ironically, on the shell casings of the bullets used in the murder. Those are three words, but have three more: *Fraud*, *Waste*, and *Abuse*. Luigi Mangione shot this man in the back with a bullet, but the cancer is in the *skin*. The cancer is in the *bones*. The cancer is in the walls and in the mirrors of this country (*Leviticus 14:33-45*)! For this is a country of murders, liars, thieves, and adulterers! And you love to have it so!

Hear the word of the LORD, ye children of Israel: for the LORD hath a controversy with the inhabitants of the land, because there is no truth, nor mercy, nor knowledge of God in the land. By swearing, and lying, and killing, and stealing, and committing adultery, they break out, and blood toucheth blood. Therefore shall the land mourn, and every one that dwelleth therein shall languish, with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven; yea, the fishes of the sea also shall be taken away. (Hosea 4:1-3).

For, behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, doth take away from Jerusalem and from Judah the stay and the staff, the whole stay of bread, and the whole stay of water, the mighty man, and the man of war, the judge, and the prophet, and the prudent, and the ancient, the captain of fifty, and the honourable man, and the counsellor, and the cunning artificer, and the eloquent orator. And I will give children to be their princes, and babes shall rule over them. And the people shall be oppressed, every one by another, and every one by his neighbour: the child shall behave himself proudly against the ancient, and the base against the honourable. (Isaiah 3:1-5)

Woe to you who have hardened your hearts against the Lord and His word. The destruction of this world is imminent; you must believe on Christ, repent of your sins, and seek the Lord with humility. **“For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon a desolation: they shall drive out Ashdod at the noon day, and Ekron shall be rooted up. Woe unto the inhabitants of the sea coast, the nation of the Cherethites! the word of the LORD is against you; O Canaan, the land of the Philistines, I will even destroy thee, that there shall be no inhabitant.”** (Zephaniah 2:4-5)
