Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2).** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

On Tuesday, Jesse Jackson died at age 84 in his Chicago home. Jesse Jackson was an evil man who propelled himself into cultural prominence using his civil rights work and his association with Martin Luther King, Jr. He was ordained a "minister" in 1968 and referred to himself as a "reverend," a middle finger to God given his push for sodomite acceptance. In 1984, he founded the political organization Rainbow Coalition in conjunction with his first run for president, whose goal was to support homosexuals through the political process. He is proud to have been the first presidential candidate to make support for homosexuals a major part of his candidacy.
