Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2)** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

This week the blood sacrifice required by the global military industrial complex escalated in the middle east. Israel and The United States continued to bomb Iran, and her allies, in subtly crafted rage against God. Iran retaliated and launched bombs across the middle east at American military assets and Israel. So far 12 countries have been struck, threatening to expand the war further. The known death toll is 1500+ lives and many more injured. Included among the reports of slaughter across varying cities, civilian infrastructure, and military installations was an Iranian girl’s school – killing 150. **“And [The LORD] said, What hast thou done? the voice of thy [sister’s] blood crieth unto me from the ground.” (Genesis 4:10-11)** A very official investigation is being conducted by The Pentagon to absolve themselves of all wrongdoing for obliterating 150 little girls: spraying the land with gallons of their blood. **“The LORD trieth the righteous: but the wicked and him that loveth violence his soul hateth.” (Psalms 11:5).** What cruel and senseless sin. What if that was your daughter? **Thou shalt not kill. (Exodus 20:13).** Life is the very breath of God and belongs solely to Him. **“See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand.” (Deuteronomy 32:39)** To steal life, whether with intent, by negligence, or by complete accident is the theft of God’s property **“And he that killeth any man shall surely be put to death.” (Leviticus 24:17)** Uttering the seance “national security” will not absolve you. Every single drop of stolen blood screams out to God, its creator, and will be answered. **“Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment: But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment:” (Matthew 5: 21-22)** **“But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.” (Revelation 21:8)**

It may be that the cup of Iran’s iniquity is full and the LORD is pouring out His fury upon a desperately wicked people. Praise God. Yet that does not absolve Israel and the United States of her abominations. Rejecting Jesus Christ, the Son of God - as God – is one of the many common sins between Judaism and Islam. Ayatollah Khomeini, the first Supreme Leader of Iran, gained prominent power in part by his writing *Clarification of the Means of Salvation* in which he repugnantly expounds “Intercourse with a woman is not allowed unless she attains the age of nine years regardless whether the marriage is permanent or temporary. There is, however, no objection in other enjoyments like touching lasciviously, hugging and rubbing the thighs, even with a suckling infant.” The west’s façade of moral authority is shattering before our eyes. Over the past month, former Prime Minister of Israel Ehud Barak’s ties to Jeffery Epstein and the unspeakable abominations that surrounded him have unraveled. Similarly, this week the Justice Department was forced to release documents containing, unsubstantiated, claims against President Donald Trump and Epstein. There is no righteousness in any of it. Repent.

O Assyrian, the rod of mine anger, and the staff in their hand is mine indignation. I will send him against an hypocritical nation, and against the people of my wrath will I give him a charge, to take the spoil, and to take the prey, and to tread them down like the mire of the streets. Howbeit he meaneth not so, neither doth his heart think so; but it is in his heart to destroy and cut off nations not a few...Wherefore it shall come to pass, that when the Lord hath performed his whole work ...I will punish the fruit of the stout heart of the king of Assyria, and the glory of his high looks. For he saith, By the strength of my hand I have done it, and by my wisdom;...Shall the axe boast itself against him that heweth therewith? or shall the saw magnify itself against him that shaketh it? as if the rod should shake itself against them that lift it up, or as if the staff should lift up itself, as if it were no wood. Isaiah 10: 5-15
