## Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2)** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

**For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have sufficient to finish it? Lest haply, after he hath laid the foundation, and is not able to finish it, all that behold it begin to mock him, Saying, This man began to build, and was not able to finish. Or what king, going to make war against another king, sitteth not down first, and consulteth whether he be able with ten thousand to meet him that cometh against him with twenty thousand? (Luke 14: 28-31)** It is day sixteen of the US-Iranian war as of the publishing date of this flier. While there have been no significant military operations this past week, it has been made clear by Motjaba Khamenei - named the new Iranian Supreme Leader last Sunday - that there are no plans at present for a ceasefire. Trump’s administration has just begun coming to terms with the long-lasting repercussions of this war that are now making themselves known: namely the steadily rising oil/gas prices, an increased fear of a potential U.S. Military Draft, and an escalating number of Muslim terrorist attacks on US soil. Thursday alone saw two separate instances of Islamic terror when one radical in Oakland, Michigan rammed his vehicle into the Temple Israel synagogue, and another open fired on a classroom at Virginia’s Dominion University leaving one dead, two wounded. And these are in addition to the previous week’s incidents that included a shooting at a bar in Texas that killed three, and attempted bombing outside of Mayor Mamdani’s residence in New York. **Then said Jeremiah unto him, The LORD hath not called thy name Pashur, but Magormissabib. For thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will make thee a terror to thyself, and to all thy friends: and they shall fall by the sword of their enemies, and thine eyes shall behold it: and I will give all Judah into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall carry them captive into Babylon, and shall slay them with the sword. (Jer 20: 3-4)** Indeed, by wielding the sword against Iran in direct contradiction to the directive of God, America has become a terror to itself. **They chose new gods; then was war in the gates: was there a shield or spear seen among forty thousand in Israel? (Judges 5:8)** It is clear by the actions of his administration, especially in these last eight months, that Donald Trump sees himself and America as the deliverers of divine justice, self-appointed avengers against incursive, repressive, evil regimes. **Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord. (Romans 12:19)** Well, take heed Mr. President: Ancient Israel no doubt thought the same when delivering its “justice” to the tribe of Benjamin to recompense it for the foul sins of Gibeah. The result? Well, justice indeed was meted out, but not to Benjamin only; 40,000 dead from Judah and its sister tribes, a meet reward for their own hypocrisy and sinful self-indulgence. **See all of Judges 19 – 21.**

Woe to you who have hardened your hearts against the Lord and His word. The destruction of this world is imminent; you must believe on Christ, repent of your sins, and seek the Lord with humility. **“For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon a desolation: they shall drive out Ashdod at the noon day, and Ekron shall be rooted up. Woe unto the inhabitants of the sea coast, the nation of the Cherethites! the word of the LORD is against you; O Canaan, the land of the Philistines, I will even destroy thee, that there shall be no inhabitant.” (Zephaniah 2:4-5)**
