The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. Let's view some of this week's judgments from the proper perspective:

*"We have achieved overwhelming Air Dominance and Superiority over the Iranian skies...We have rescued the seriously wounded, and really brave, F-15 Crew Member/Officer, from deep inside the mountains of Iran...An AMAZING show of bravery and talent by all....God Bless our great MILITARY WARRIORS!"*

President Trump posted these words on *Truth Social*, but these are very proud boasts that subvert the truth of God and steal His glory.

***In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will: That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. (Ephesians 1:12)***

***But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: that no flesh should glory in his presence. (1 Corinthians 1:27-29)***

***Thus saith the LORD; Deceive not yourselves, saying, The Chaldeans shall surely depart from us: for they shall not depart. For though ye had smitten the whole army of the Chaldeans that fight against you, and there remained but wounded men among them, yet should they rise up every man in his tent, and burn this city with fire. (Jeremiah 37:9-10)***

In all your talk of "overwhelming Air Dominance and Superiority", you forget yourself Mr. President, and you do trust in horses (*Psalm 33:16-17*). God is the one who controls cause and effect. It is not the talent of your soldiers or the speed of your aircrafts that determined this outcome.
