Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God.

“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2). The big story of the week is the peace talks between the U.S.A. and Iran. As soon as the peace talks failed the U.S.A. started a blockade of all ships attempting to pass through the Strait of Hormuz. The U.S.A. is claiming Iran is refusing to commit to not develop nuclear weapons. U.S.A.’s Vice President JD Vance said, “The bad news is that we have not reached an agreement, and I think that’s bad news for Iran much more than it’s bad news for the United States of America.” Also, President Trump told Fox News that Iran will give the U.S.A. “Everything we want.” Mr. President, thou shalt not kill!
